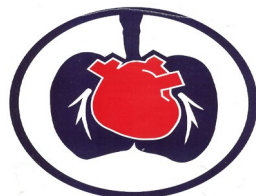




# ADULT CARDIOVASCULAR PATHOLOGY

Topics covered include: sudden cardiac death, valvular heart disease, cardiomyopathies, inherited cardiac disease, myocarditis, and post-operative deaths.
