The Department of Pathology of the Cleveland Clinic is seeking a full-time **Cardiovascular Pathologist** to join our subspecialized practice. The section of Cardiovascular Pathology examines approximately 7,000 specimens that include endomyocardial biopsies, explanted hearts, aortic aneurysms, valvular resections, arterial and vein biopsies, prosthetic devices, pacing leads, complex post-cardiovascular surgery autopsies and extramural consults. Our section is also home to a Cardiovascular Pathology Fellowship Program. As we continue to expand our volume and outreach program, we are seeking cardiovascular pathology fellowship-trained candidates with strong diagnostic skills and scholarly accomplishments in the field, with a desire to actively participate on a busy cardiovascular and autopsy practice, engage in cardiology fellows, pathology residents and medical school teaching, participate in weekly multidisciplinary conferences, and contribute to clinical or translational research.
